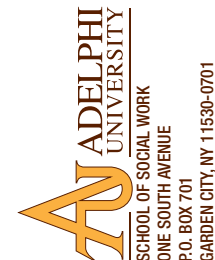

“Implementing Evidence-Based Interventions: A Social Worker’s Dilemma or Delight?”

Evidence-Based Practices have been developed for various clinical disciplines, providing standardized treatment and interventions based on research and outcome evidence. Dr. Shriver’s presentation will trace the history and development of Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) and consider its application in social work practice. A faculty panel will discuss implementation of EBP for social work in healthcare, aging, mental health, and addictions.

ABOUT THE PRESENTER

KREN SHRIVER, M.P.H., M.D.

Kren K. Shriver, M.P.H., M.D., is the Director of Clinical Services at Hudson River Psychiatric Center (HRPC) in Poughkeepsie, New York. Dr. Shriver received his Bachelor of Arts degree from Johns Hopkins University, his Master of Public Health from Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene and Public Health, and his doctorate in medicine from Saint Louis University Medical School. He completed his residency in adult psychiatry at Mount Sinai Medical Center, where he served as chief resident, and is board certified in adult psychiatry.

Upon completion of his residency in 1991, Dr. Shriver worked at Elmhurst Hospital Medical Center, initially as medical director of the mobile crisis team, then as director of the Comprehensive Psychiatric Emergency Program (CPEP). In addition to his position at HRPC, Dr. Shriver serves as a member on both the OMH Clinical Subcabinet and the Rational Pharmacotherapy of Schizophrenia Steering Committee. He is a clinical assistant professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at New York Medical College and participated as a member of two Expert Consensus Panels to develop guidelines for the treatment of behavioral emergencies.



ABOUT THE PRESENTATION

Attendees will understand what Evidence-Based Practice (EBP) is, why it is important, and be able to use it in their work with clients.

ABOUT THE PANEL

Dr. Judy Fenster is associate professor and faculty chair for Curriculum and Instruction at the Adelphi University School of Social Work, where she teaches in the M.S.W. and Ph.D. programs. Dr. Fenster’s areas of expertise include substance abuse and social work pedagogy.

Dr. Richard Francoeur is associate professor at the Adelphi University School of Social Work. His areas of expertise include healthcare and aging, issues of medical and symptom comorbidity, and late-life depression. Dr. Francoeur’s current research focuses on factors affecting patients receiving palliative care.

Dr. Patricia Joyce is associate professor at the Adelphi University School of Social Work. Her fields of expertise include child sexual abuse, qualitative research, and mental health. Dr. Joyce’s research interests include qualitative research on: trauma, incest, mental illness, and post-traumatic stress disorder.
