SUBSTANCE ABUSE

**Drug and alcohol outpatient program 8
Islip, NY**

A drug and alcohol outpatient program. Interns are placed in either Brentwood or West Islip program sites. Individuals with alcohol or substance abuse, their family members and significant others, are served. Interns provide intake and assessment, co-facilitate groups, as well as work with individual clients. Day and Evening hours.

SUBSTANCE ABUSE

**Drug and alcohol outpatient program 2
Bronx, NY**

This agency offers a range of clinic based day treatment and adult outpatient programs for people with addiction. Assignments include individual and group work (primarily relapse prevention, psychoeducation, living skills).

**Alcoholism Counseling Services 7
Glen Cove, NY**

This agency is an outpatient alcohol treatment facility providing both individual and family centered services. The population consists of both mandated and voluntary clients, English and Spanish speaking. Opportunities are available to students in individual, family, play therapy and group modalities. Minimum 1 to 2 evenings per week required.

**In patient drug and alcohol treatment facility
Bronx, NY**

In patient drug and alcohol treatment facility. Has some evening hours.

**Community based outpatient substance abuse 7
Baldwin, NY**

This is a community based outpatient substance abuse treatment program which provides psycho dynamically oriented treatment to mandated and voluntary clients and families. Accommodates extended students with some daytime hours required. Thursday afternoon required.

**Community based outpatient substance abuse 3, 7, 6, 1
Brooklyn, Bethpage, Staten Island and New York, NY**

This is a community based outpatient substance abuse treatment program with multiple locations and services, including individual and group treatment with mandated and voluntary clients and families. Offers some evening hours.

**Medical Center - Addiction Services 4
Jamaica, NY**

This methadone clinic provides methadone maintenance and supportive counseling to individuals with opiate addiction. Students work individually with clients and collaterally with significant others in assessing progress, exploring new behaviors and planning for continuing psychosocial needs. Clinic operates early AM through PM hours.

**Mental health and substance abuse services 7
Hempstead, NY**

This agency provides an array of services to multi-cultural clients of mixed socio-economic background. Mental health and substance abuse services are provided to individuals, families and groups. Students will co-lead a psycho-educational group for incarcerated mothers and will develop other groups focused on behavioral change. Offers some evening hours.

**Substance Abuse Program 5
Dobbs Ferry, NY**

This is a residential child welfare setting serving adolescents with substance abuse problems. Students work in a primary counseling role with children who are placed in one of the cottage programs. Individual, group and family modalities are utilized.

**Substance Abuse Program 7
Great Neck, NY**

Multi-service community based substance abuse treatment agency providing clinical and academic/vocational services to adolescent and adult mandated and voluntary clients. A multi-disciplinary staff offers education, testing, assessment and treatment planning. Individual, family, group, crisis intervention, linkage and advocacy services are emphasized. Serves both mandated and voluntary clients. Minimum 1 to 2 evenings per week required

**Substance Abuse Program 7
Garden City, NY**

Outpatient day treatment facility for people with substance abuse problems. Individual group and milieu treatment. Day time hours required.

**Substance Abuse Program 7, 4, 2
Hempstead, Jamaica and Brooklyn, NY**

This is an outpatient substance abuse treatment program funded by NCDAD and US courts. Clients served are mandated criminal justice clients who are referred by Probation and Parole officers on the county, state and federal levels. Clients are provided with both individual and group counseling. Offers some evening hours

Substance Abuse Program 4
Queens Village, NY

This is a residential state-run facility providing services for substance-involved adults, many of whom are mandated for treatment. In this fast-paced setting, students conduct intakes, write psychosocial assessments, and run groups.

Substance Abuse Services 1
New York, NY

This is an out-patient substance abuse counseling center for adults. Services include psycho-social assessments, individual and group counseling. Some clients referred are on parole, probation, or federal halfway house residents. Evening hours available.

Multi service agency 9
Heightstown, NJ

Multi service agency providing individual, marital, family, alcohol and drug assessments to groups including D.W.I. groups, etc. Population served: all ages, from diverse socioeconomic and multicultural backgrounds, specialized family therapy training opportunity including large Hispanic population. **Evening and/or Saturday A.M. hours required.**

Substance Abuse Program 1
New York, New York

This is a comprehensive substance abuse treatment setting offering intensive out-patient counseling, family treatment and group work. Adult and adolescent population. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

Family Alcoholism Counseling and Treatment Center 7
Long Beach, NY

This is a mental health and chemical dependency treatment agency in Long Beach, New York, serving a multi-cultural, mixed socio-economic, bilingual population. Students will carry a caseload of individual clients which include family sessions, and lead both short and long term groups. Some community organization and research work will also be available to the intern. Some evening work may be necessary. Staff meetings are on Friday mornings.

Substance Abuse Program 7
Long Beach, NY

This is an agency providing individual, family and group substance abuse counseling with a focus on adolescents. Students have the opportunity to do both individual and group work as well as provide advocacy services for troubled adolescents.

State Hospital-Division of Substance Abuse 1
New York, NY

This is an in-patient facility located on Ward's Island serving primarily a MICA population. Services include individual and group counseling, case management and discharge planning. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours. Spanish-speaking preferred.

Substance Abuse Program 7
Garden City, NY

Alcohol/substance abuse outpatient treatment facility which utilizes a disease model approach. Students provide individual, family and educational group services.

Substance Abuse Program 7
West Hempstead, NY

This satellite substance abuse clinic of this Hospital serves individuals, families, couples and groups providing a full range of clinical services. Clients are both mandated and voluntary, beginning at age 13. The agency services a culturally and socio-economically diverse population from Nassau and Queens. In addition, the agency has a day treatment Mica program (P.O.E.T.).

Substance Abuse Programs 7, 4
New Hyde Park, NY

Substance abuse treatment agencies serving chemically dependant adolescents and adult populations utilizing a range of modalities in a combination of disease and mental health treatment approaches. Settings include Outpatient programs in Bayside, Elmont, and a Methadone Maintenance Program (an outpatient program operating from approximately 6:30am to 3:00pm serving opiate dependent individuals). Students provide clinical social work services with individuals, groups and families. **Minimum 1 to 2 evenings per week required.** Work with mandated and voluntary clients. Strong Spanish speaking population served in Mineola.

Substance Abuse Services 7
Glen Cove, NY

This community based program for adolescents and adults offers a wide range of substance abuse treatment services, including a **Women's and Children's Program (WCP)**, an **Adolescent Services Unit (ASU)** and a **Drug-Free Outpatient Program (DFO)**. Students will be involved in intake, interdisciplinary planning, individual, family and group counseling.

University Hospital 7
Manhasset, NY

UH has approximately eight different sites for students in medical and psychiatric and chemical dependency social work settings. Medical settings may include: Inpatient Medical/Surgical Unit; Home Care; Child Development (serving children and adults who present chronic conditions including birth defects and genetic diseases); Oncology, and Neurology Units. Psychiatric Settings may include inpatient adolescent and adult units, outpatient and day treatment services. Chemical Dependency setting includes ambulatory and Day Treatment services. Student assignments include providing individual and group counseling, case management services, discharge planning, advocacy and outreach. Students have access to Grand Rounds, student seminars, department meetings and other medical center activities.

Substance Abuse Program 7

Freeport, NY

This is a drug abuse treatment and prevention agency located in a mixed socio-economic area. Social work students have the opportunity to work with individuals and groups and to become involved with community organization work. Prevention focuses on youth and youth groups.

Substance Abuse Program 2 8**Brentwood, NY**

This is a residential setting for a young adult population who are in need of intensive residential treatment for chemical dependency problems. Students provide individual and group counseling, crisis intervention and psycho education services. Setting is able to accommodate substantial evening/weekend hours. (Also Bellport location – offers some evening hours)

Outpatient Services 4**NY**

The outpatient services of the outreach project include an alcohol and cocaine treatment program; assessment and referral offices; an education and training center; and a career assessment and development unit. Students work with clients individually and in groups who are in recovery from chemical dependency. There are opportunities to learn about career assessment resource tools, and vocational testing.

Substance Abuse Program 8**Coram, NY (with additional sites in Ronkonkoma and Moriches)**

This is an outpatient chemical dependency setting providing individual, group and family services to a diverse client population including both mandated and voluntary patients. Weekly group supervision and case conferences supplement individual supervision. Offers some evening hours.

Chemical Dependency Program 8**Huntington, NY**

This is the substance abuse unit providing substance abuse treatment to a wide range of clients. Offers some evening hours.

Substance Abuse Program 7**Bethpage, NY**

A not-for-profit community based outpatient substance abuse program which provides individual, group and family services. The program also has a family and children's services component, as well as a school-based prevention component. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

Substance Abuse Services 1**New York, NY**

This agency provides comprehensive substance abuse services within a male residential resocialization program based in Harlem. Focus is on individual and group counseling, Housing Assistance, HIV counseling and prevention, vocational/educational services and advocacy. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

Substance Abuse Program 8**Wainscott, East Hampton, NY**

This agency is an adolescent residential chemical dependency treatment center. They offer individual and group treatment in a TC (therapeutic community behavior mod) setting. Evening and weekend student intern hours are possible (after scrutiny by the clinical staff.) An interdisciplinary treatment team.

Counseling Center 7**Port Washington, NY**

Community based substance abuse agency. Assignments include mandated clients, voluntary clients and family members. Modality is primarily individual, but groups are assigned to each student. In addition, there is community outreach to minority families through a cooperative effort to provide counseling at a local church, as well as an outreach effort at a housing project. This assignment requires students with above average performance in first year field work. Two nights are required. The approach to working with clients incorporates psycho dynamically oriented counseling, psycho education (a major modality used in the groups) as well as techniques specific to substance abusers and their families.

Substance Abuse Program 7**Roosevelt, NY**

This is an outpatient drug and alcohol program serving the Hispanic Community. Students must be bilingual in Spanish. Assignments will include individual and group work dealing with substance abuse.

Substance Abuse Program 7**Plainview, NY**

A substance abuse treatment agency with student assignments conducting intakes and providing counseling with individuals and families. Ages served 11 - adult. Offers some evening hours.

Substance Abuse Program 4**Jamaica, NY**

This is a residential substance abuse treatment facility. Students conduct intakes, provide individual and group counseling. Offers some evening and weekend hours.

Substance Abuse Program 8**Amityville, NY**

Comprehensive chemical dependency program. Students work with individuals, groups and do discharge planning. Offers some evening hours.

Substance Abuse Program 8

Westhampton Beach, NY

This is an inpatient facility where students provide group and individual counseling to clients with substance abuse issues. Day and some evening hours available

**Alcohol Treatment Center 6
Staten Island, NY**

This is a comprehensive substance abuse treatment setting offering intensive out-patient counseling, family treatment and group work. Adult and adolescent population.

**Child Guidance CARES 7
Freeport, NY**

A treatment and prevention program for children and families involved in alcohol related problems. The student (practitioner) provides individual, group, family treatment. Development of play-activity therapy skills is significant to the learning experience in this setting. 2 sites

**Substance Abuse Program 7
Wantagh, NY**

This agency has two separate programs which students can be placed in:

1. Drug Program - Wantagh, NY

This agency provides outpatient counseling to mandated and voluntary clients with drug problems. Intake, case presentations, psycho education, individual counseling, family counseling and groups comprise the field work assignment. In addition, some students are assigned to the intensive outpatient rehabilitation program which organizes treatment by levels of recovery. This is a (suitable) evening and Saturday assignment. Students may be required to work additional evening hours based on client needs and space constraints.

2. Alcohol Program - Wantagh

This program provides outpatient counseling to mandated and voluntary clients with alcohol problems. Students will be assigned psychosocial assessments, individual clients and groups. There is also opportunity for work with children, individually and in groups.

**Medical Center 5
Yonkers, NY**

The Program is an outpatient, drug-free treatment program addressing a wide range of problems for clients of diverse ethnic, cultural and socioeconomic status. Students are assigned (a caseload) of clients for individual treatment as well as several groups, including an orientation group and a relapse prevention group.

**Child and Family Services 4
Long Island City, N.Y.**

This is a substance abuse treatment agency which services a wide range of clients and is located in the very diverse community of Astoria/Long Island City. Clients range in age from school age children, adolescents and adults and are seen individually and in group sessions.

**Youth Services 7
Woodmere, NY**

This is a substance abuse prevention, treatment and mental health agency serving the 5-Towns Community. Students provide individual, family and group services. Assignments are made to local schools to intervene educationally, identify and provide short-term treatment. Students also are assigned to the lounge where teenagers assemble for social/recreational programs.

**Community based drug and alcohol clinic 8
Amityville, NY**

Community based drug and alcohol clinic serving mandated and voluntary clients who are provided with a full range of clinical and support services. Population is ethnically, culturally and economically mixed.

**Consultation Services 9
Union City, New Jersey**

This agency, located outside Lincoln Tunnel (accessible via public transportation from NJ, NY, Bronx, and Westchester) provides prevention, Parenting groups, AIDS Family (children with parents with AIDS) and alcohol treatment program for adolescents and families. Stipend for 2nd year interns may be available- this requires one week paid training in July at Rutgers Alcohol Institute, NJ.

HEALTHCARE**Breast Cancer Support Program 7
Garden City, NY**

This program provides hotline support and information and referral services to those afflicted with breast cancer on Long Island and throughout NY State. Short and long term support groups are run throughout the year. Students lead groups, provide individual counseling and help administer the hotline and advocacy components of the project.

**Skilled nursing facility 8
Huntington Station, NY**

This is a skilled nursing facility that provides short term care to individuals and their families. Day hours only.

**Community based organization 4
Rego Park and Far Rockaway, NY**

This community based organization provides a full range of services to person's affected by HIV and AIDS. Students provide individual and group counseling, home visiting, linkage to resources and services, education and prevention program.

Hospital 2

Bronx, NY

A multi-discipline, large health care facility with placements in the in-patient rehabilitation unit, the ICU floors and the Emergency Room.

Pediatric AIDS Program 3**Brooklyn, NY**

Clinical assessments and counseling to individuals and families affected by HIV/AIDS. Group work, education, inter-disciplinary collaboration and treatment planning.

Hospital 8**Patchogue, NY**

Inpatient Psychiatry-individual and group counseling with clients diagnosed with psychiatric disorders. Day hours only.

Emergency Room- evening hours providing crisis intervention and referrals for individuals with psychiatric disorders.

Hospital - Department of Social Work Services 2**Bronx, NY**

This is an inpatient hospital setting for people with advanced terminal illness. Students provide clinical services to individuals and family members including planning around continuing care needs, bereavement counseling, individual, couple and family work.

Support services 7**Woodbury, Manhattan, NY**

This is the Long Island office which provides a range of support services for cancer patients and their families. Intakes bereavement group, individual counseling and couple counseling comprise student assignments.

Supportive counseling provided for cancer patients, survivors and their families

Medical Group 3**Brooklyn, NY**

Social Services within an HMO environment. Will include psycho-social assessments, crisis counseling, individual and family counseling, case management with a culturally diverse population. Student might be located at more than one site for field placement

Hospital 8**Riverhead, NY**

A community hospital serving a diverse socio-economic population. The placement within the social work department provides students with assignments within the med/surg units and the maternity unit. Students provide screening, discharge planning, counseling and placement services. In addition, the intern may provide crisis intervention in the Emergency room on a rotating basis.

Hospital 4**Roosevelt Island, NY**

This is a long-term care facility addressing physical, social and psychological needs of patients. Treatment covers medical/surgical care, rehabilitation, respiratory therapy, AIDS treatment to children and adults. Assignments include individual, family, group counseling, case management with diverse age, ethnic population.

Hospital 3**Brooklyn, NY**

A multi-discipline, large health care facility with placements in the in-patient rehabilitation unit, the ICU floors and the Emergency Room.

Hospital 4**(see also Mount Sinai Services)****Elmhurst, NY**

This tertiary care, teaching medical center offers primary and secondary assignments throughout the hospital including adolescent health, family health, adolescent and adult psychiatry, ob/gyn, infectious diseases and mobile crisis. Additional learning opportunities include student seminars, department meetings and related in service training.

Hospital 7**Franklin Square, NY**

This hospital offers placements in the Medical-Surgical Units, the Adult Day Program and the Geriatric Care Center. Students provide individual work to patients with a range of medical diagnoses within an interdisciplinary approach. Discharge planning, linkage to other community services and brief short term counseling. Some longer term counseling is also available.

Health Systems 2, 1**Bronx and Manhattan**

This umbrella organization includes placements within **Morisania Hospital and Lincoln Hospital** in the Bronx and **Metropolitan Hospital and Harlem Hospital** in Manhattan as well as several community-based Diagnostic and Treatment Centers. All are large, urban medical facilities offering a comprehensive range of social work services including psychosocial assessment, individual and family counseling, group work, case management, and crisis intervention. Placements on various services possible including Emergency Room, general medical, child and adolescent, alcohol and substance abuse treatment, geriatric and home health care. Opportunity to work in a fast-paced, inter-disciplinary setting with a culturally diverse population. Some evening/week-end hours may be available at Harlem and Lincoln Hospitals.

Hospital 1**New York, NY**

A multi-discipline, large health care facility on West 135th Street and Lenox Avenue in Manhattan. Opportunities for learning have included work on the in-patient rehabilitation floor (where patients stay for 2-3 weeks), and the ICU floors for assessment work, as well as the Emergency Room (assessment and referral).

Multi-service day treatment program 2, 1**Brooklyn and New York, NY**

A multi-service day treatment program for HIV/AIDS clients, many of whom reside in their on-site housing . Opportunities include individual and group counseling within a therapeutic milieu environment, case management and advocacy. Substance abuse counseling and treatment services offered.

Hospice 7

Bay Shore and Westbury, NY

A community-based home health agency providing comprehensive services to the terminally ill and to their families. Opportunities for students include individual, family and group work with all ages in an interdisciplinary model.

Hospital 2

Bronx, NY

The Department of Social Work offers students the opportunity to work with individuals and families on a short and long term basis. Students will provide case management services, counseling, psychosocial assessments, and crisis intervention and advocacy services.

Hospital 4

Jamaica, NY

This is an acute voluntary teaching hospital serving a predominantly low income, diverse ethnic population. Social work students carry varied caseloads of adult and older adult patients and their families. Diagnosis include: trauma, AIDS, cancer, strokes, amputations, substance abuse, etc. Social work students provide counseling, referral, discharge planning services and consult with interdisciplinary team.

Hospital 9

Jersey City, NJ

A large city hospital center, placement on the children's partial care unit. Assignment includes work with individual children and families, individually, and in groups. Team meetings, in-service training and community work all available. (Population consists of many different immigrant groups.) Diverse client population.

Hospital 8

Port Jefferson, NY

Community based medical facility offering a variety of opportunities in several units: the medical /surgical unit, discharge planning and short term counseling, the Adult Psychiatric Unit working with individuals and groups on a short-term basis and the Adolescent Psych Unit, working with adolescents and families.

Hospital 2

Bronx, NY

A multi-discipline, large health care facility located in the South Bronx. Student assignments have been in the Emergency Department of the trauma center and have included long and short term casework with individuals and families, advocacy, and referral information.

Mental Health Center 3

Brooklyn, NY

Placements are available within out-patient mental health clinic. Opportunity to participate with inter-disciplinary treatment team. Psycho-social assessments, individual, couples, family and group counseling. Second year MSWs only.

Hospice 3

Brooklyn, NY

A home-based, inter-disciplinary program providing medical and supportive services to terminally ill individuals and families. Student assignments include individual and family counseling, bereavement counseling, support groups. Services offered at in-patient unit and in homes. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

Hospital 1

New York, NY

This facility has extensive In Patient and Out Patient services: HIV/AIDS clinic, oncology, prenatal services, and an extensive program of mental health service. The intern usually rotates from the In Patient to the Out Patient facilities and works with other disciplines (i.e., Nursing, Psychiatry, Nutrition, and Medicine). Day and evening hours offered.

Hospice 3

Brooklyn, NY

A home-based, inter-disciplinary program providing medical and supportive services to terminally ill patients and families. Student assignments include individual and family counseling, bereavement counseling, support groups. Services offered at in-patient unit and in homes.

Hospital

Elmhurst, NY

This tertiary care, teaching medical center offers primary and secondary assignments throughout the hospital including adolescent health, family health, adolescent and adult psychiatry, ob/gyn, emergency medicine and mobile crisis. Additional learning opportunities include weekly student seminars, department meetings and related in-service training.

Hospital 7

East Meadow, NY

A tertiary care hospital setting with a broad array of departments and opportunities for student placements. Students are assigned individual cases in a primary service (i.e.: pediatrics, psychiatry, etc.). Group and community organization assignments are available. This is a demanding, structured placement with many rich learning options.

Hospital 1

New York, NY

A multi-discipline, large health care facility. Student assignments have been in the Emergency Department of the trauma center and have included long and short term casework with patients and families, advocacy, referral and information.

**Dialysis 7
Manhasset, NY**

Out patient dialysis treatment. Day and evening hours.

**Health System 7
New Hyde Park, NY**

A large acute care hospital presenting many opportunities for student assignments and training. Previous placements have included working in the HIV Case Management Program providing counseling and concrete services to HIV infected individuals and their caregivers; The Satellite Dialysis Unit, offering students opportunities to work as part of team with patients with end stage renal disease; Medical Surgical Service, offer counseling and concrete services to a wide range of patients with acute illnesses; Home Care, working with predominantly with older adults and caregivers in their homes around issues of adjustment to medical conditions. Students also have opportunities for secondary assignments within the Instructional Center.

**Hospital 4
Forest Hills, NY**

A comprehensive in-patient facility offering a broad spectrum of social work services. Opportunities exist for students on various units including medical/surgical, pediatric, oncology, rehabilitation. Services include assessment, crisis-intervention, short-term counseling and discharge planning.

**Hospital 7
Manhasset, NY**

NSUH has approximately eight different sites for students in medical and psychiatric and chemical dependency social work settings. Medical settings may include: Inpatient Medical/Surgical Unit; Home Care; Child Development (serving children and adults who present chronic conditions including birth defects and genetic diseases); Oncology, and Neurology Units. Psychiatric Settings may include inpatient adolescent and adult units, outpatient and day treatment services. Chemical Dependency setting includes ambulatory and Day Treatment services. Student assignments include providing individual and group counseling, case management services, discharge planning, advocacy and outreach. Students have access to Grand Rounds, student seminars, department meetings and other medical center activities.

**Prenatal counseling 7
Hempstead, N.Y.**

A unit of a national organization providing prenatal counseling, ob/gyn, AIDS/HIV testing and counseling. Brief short term counseling. Day time hours only.

**Rehabilitation and Health Care Center 4
Jackson Heights, New York**

A comprehensive health care center offering an opportunity for on-going counseling, care planning to residents and families. Psycho-social assessments, inter-disciplinary collaboration, group facilitation.

**Health Care Center 4
Rego Park, New York**

A comprehensive health care center including long-term care, sub-acute and short-term rehabilitation services. Opportunity for psycho-social assessment, inter-disciplinary care planning, individual and family counseling, discharge planning. Opportunity to work with Alzheimer's patients if interested.

**Children's Hospital 7
New Hyde Park, NY**

This acute care children's teaching medical center provides a variety of student assignments which have included pediatric oncology, outpatient psychiatry, adolescent medicine, etc. Students may work with children and adolescents around social/emotional problems, work with parents, adolescent groups, and coverage of a clinic telephone crisis service, neo-natal service, preschool screening with children with developmental difficulties and working in a child abuse screening program.

**Hospital 7
Oceanside, NY**

As part of a multi-disciplinary team, students provide discharge planning, linkage to other community services, short-term counseling, and occasional long-term counseling to a diverse socio-economic population with a range of diagnosis within this medical setting.

**Hospital 8
Bay Shore, NY**

A hospital setting offering a range of placement possibilities including work in the Brain Injury and Coma recovery program, cardiac Care, Cancer and Infectious Diseases (AIDS and TB) units. Students will be able to provide assessment, concrete services, short-term individual and group work and treatment planning.

**Hospital 7
Port Washington, NY**

Provide psychosocial supportive counseling and discharge planning services to individuals and their families who have been hospitalized with various medical conditions.

**Medical Center 9
Trenton, NJ**

A 430 bed, general acute care hospital serving residents of Trenton, NJ and the surrounding community. Students provide services in the Social Service/Home Care Department and receive weekly individual supervision. Students complete assessments of psychosocial

functioning, and provide concrete services, PRN. Individual, family, and group treatment may be provided, as students assess needs and secure linkages with community resources. Services are provided to both in- and out-patients.

**Residential Health Care Facility 1
New York, NY**

40 bed In Patient Rehabilitative and Hospice Facility for individuals with end stage HIV/AIDS. Interns conduct group and individual counseling sessions, visit patients while in hospital to determine their suitability for St.Mary's, and they also provide referrals for concrete service. The facility offers both evening and weekend hours for interns.

**Medical Center 8
Stony Brook, NY**

This teaching medical center provides assignments in a range of medical and psychiatric services including neo-natal, renal dialysis, surgery, neurology, and in-patient psychiatry. Students will be involved in case management, discharge planning, problem solving activities, and short-term counseling with individuals and families. Well-developed in-service training program. Opportunities for group work are limited.

**Medical Center 3
Brooklyn, NY**

The Department of Social Work offers students the opportunity to work with individuals and families on a short and long term basis. Students will provide case management services, counseling, psychosocial assessments, and crisis intervention and advocacy services.

**Medical Center 3
Brooklyn, NY**

A multi-function medical facility offering in-patient medical care and out-patient surgical services. Opportunity to work on various units including med/surg, oncology, pediatrics and OB/GYN. Individual, family counseling, discharge planning.

MENTAL HEALTH

**Counseling Center 7
Garden City, NY**

Provides comprehensive psychological and preventive services and programs to Adelphi University graduate and undergraduate students. SCC services include: individual, group, outreach, consultation, workshops, crisis intervention and referrals to on-campus and off-campus resources

**Outpatient mental health counseling 4
Queens, NY**

An out-patient mental health clinic offering an inter-disciplinary team approach.

**Mental Health 7
Glen Cove, NY**

A not-for-profit community based mental health agency serving the North Shore Region of Nassau County. Presenting problems include chronic mental illness, characterological issues and clients dealing with situational life stresses. Services are provided to children, adolescents and adults utilizing a multi-modality approach.

**Employee Assistance Team 7
Elmont, NY**

Student will provide individual and group counseling to the employees of the Belmont Park Racetrack. The student will participate in the day to day operations of an EAP program that addresses the needs of an underserved, disenfranchised population.

**Mental Health Center 8
Hauppauge, NY**

Full service mental health clinic affiliated with the Suffolk County Department of Mental Health. Students work with individuals, groups, couples and families around a broad range of problems and psychiatric disorders. Possible evening hours available. Daytime supervision.

**Hospital 3
Brooklyn, NY**

A psychiatric in-patient unit. Students engage in assessment of high risk patients for counseling and concrete services. Opportunities for individual, group, and systems practice. Students participate in interdisciplinary teams and attend a broad range of in-services meetings.

**Hospital 8
Patchogue, NY**

Inpatient Psychiatry-individual and group counseling with clients diagnosed with psychiatric disorders. Day hours only.

Emergency Room- evening hours providing crisis intervention and referrals for individuals with psychiatric disorders.

**Psychiatric Centers 3
Brooklyn, NY**

This agency covers outpatient mental health clinics, a mobile geriatric team, and day treatment program for older adults, school-based mental health program. Population served is primarily lower middle class, 70% white and 30% ethnic minorities. Modalities include individual, group and family treatment for a client population age 5 and up.

**Care Plus of New Jersey 9
Paramus, NJ**

This is an intensive case management program for persons with chronic mental illness housed in the community. Extensive outreach to individuals in their homes. Inter-disciplinary team approach. Individual counseling and extensive advocacy. Some evening hours available.

Out-patient mental health clinics 1, 2, 5**New York, Bronx, Yonkers and Peekskill**

Placements are available within out-patient mental health clinics in northern Manhattan (Washington Heights), Inwood, Bronx and Westchester. Opportunity to participate with inter-disciplinary treatment team. Psychosocial assessments, individual, couples, family and group counseling. Educational programming for students. Some limited evening hours available. Spanish speaking a plus.

Case Management 4**Astoria, New York**

Individual and group counseling with adolescents involved in GED preparation program. Intake and assessment, crisis intervention and case management.

Mental Health Clinic 4**Glendale, NY**

A community mental health center serving a Queens population composed of working class, ethnically diverse population. Social work students provide psychotherapeutic services to individuals, families and groups of all ages with some opportunities for collaboration with community agencies. Clinical issues include: sexual abuse, family violence, divorce, substance abuse, school problems, etc.

Community Support Services (CSS) 4**Far Rockaway, NY**

Provides on-site mental health services in adult homes on the Rockaway Peninsula. Students may be placed in an adult home facility servicing the chronically mentally ill and work with both individuals and groups with a focus on providing linkage to medical psychiatric and rehabilitation services and community social service agencies. Students may also provide case management services.

Mental Health Services 4**Far Rockaway, NY**

Operates a full service outpatient mental health and a mobile crisis (after hours) program providing community based rapid assessment, crisis intervention, emergency psychiatric services and linkage to health, mental health and social services in the Far Rockaway community. Evening and weekend hours available in mobile crisis program

Counseling Center 7**Hicksville and Westbury, NY**

This multi-service substance abuse and mental health community agency provides services to voluntary and mandated clients in a variety of settings. Student placements are in the agency's **Counseling Center** which provides individual, group, couple/family counseling; the **Community Program** which provides for substance abuse treatment for a mandated and voluntary population, and the **Haven**, a MICA continuing day treatment program, providing treatment for dually diagnosed clients. Offers some evening hours.

Community Counseling Program 9**Hackensack, New Jersey**

A community counseling agency offering mental health outpatient services to children, adolescents and adults.

Supportive educational program 1**New York, NY**

A supportive educational program servicing college students, enabling them to remain in school. Case management and individual supportive counseling offered.

Counseling Services 7**Franklin Square, NY**

A community counseling agency providing a wide range of treatment services. Partially funded by Nassau County Drug and Alcohol Addiction Department, the agency sees many clients with problems related to substance abuse. Other issues that present are depression, anxiety, marital problems and life transitions. Treatment modalities include individual, couples, family and group. Social work interns collaborate with staff psychiatrist, other staff therapists and vocational counselor.

Community Health 6**Staten Island, NY**

This is a community counseling agency offering mental health outpatient services to children and families.

Mental Health Center 10**New Haven, CT**

A joint program of the Yale University Department of Psychiatry and the Connecticut Department of Mental Health and Addiction Services. Comprised of 13 agencies, they provide a comprehensive array of clinical, residential, social and vocational rehabilitation programs. Interns have the opportunity to receive training in the provisions of individual, group and family, brief and long-term psychotherapy and crisis assessment skills. They will work with clients across the life span.

Psychiatric Center 4**Queens Village, NY**

This NYS Office of Mental Health Psychiatric Center provides a broad range of psychiatric services to adults with severe mental illness. Students are assigned to inpatient and ambulatory settings including short term, intermediate care, MICA, outpatient clinic programs. Assignments include discharge planning and work with individuals and groups. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

Counseling Services 7**Greenvale, NY**

Agency provides a range of services for college age, Jewish students. Opportunities to utilize individual and group modalities as well as community organization or program development. Assignments include work with learning disabled students and interface with other

professional staff. Student must be able to work independently within a complex setting and have some knowledge of Jewish culture and traditions. Offers some evening hours.

**VA Medical Center 8
Northport, NY**

The Northport VA provides an array of student opportunities for practice with veterans and their families. Students provide individual and group counseling, engage in evaluation research and receive individual and group supervision. Setting provides an interdisciplinary approach with short and long term medical and psychiatric patients in the hospital and in community residential care.

**Department of Veterans Administration 3, 4
New York Harbor Health Care Services
Brooklyn and St. Albans, NY**

An array of student opportunities are available including inpatient and outpatient services, an extended care center and the domiciliary care unit for homeless veterans recovering from substance abuse. Assignments include individual and group counseling, referrals, outreach and crisis intervention. Emphasis is placed on collaborative efforts with members of the multi disciplinary team.

**Employee Assistance Program 1
New York, NY**

A member's assistance program/ mental health clinic, offering both long term and short term therapy.

**Mental health outpatient services 8
Westhampton Beach, NY**

A community counseling agency offering mental health outpatient services to children, adolescents and adults. They provide individual and family modalities of treatment. The director is a psychiatrist; the staff consists of social workers and counselors. The agency is open during the daytime hours and also Tues, Wed, and Thurs evenings. No weekend hours.

**Multi service agency 8
Huntington, NY**

This multi service agency provides a broad range of programs and services to residents of Suffolk County. Students have been placed in the agency's **Countywide Counseling Program** (West Islip, Huntington, Northport sites) providing clinical social work services to children and families, individuals and couples; **East Hampton Clinic** providing outpatient mental health services to individuals, families and groups with priority given to people with serious mental illness; the **East End Community Counseling** and **North Fork Counseling** programs in Mattituck providing a range of clinical services; the **Youth and Family Program** in Riverhead, NY which provides counseling services to youth and families and outreach to the community (e.g. schools).

**Multi-service agency 5
Westchester, NY**

Multi-service agency providing a wide range of mental health and social services to individuals and families though all stages of the life cycle- including such programs as: Family Mental Health, Adoption and Children's Services, Adolescent Group Homes, Therapeutic Foster Care Program, etc.

**Mental Health Clinic 5
Farmingville, NY**

A Suffolk County outpatient mental health clinic providing both short and long term services to the community as well as to the chronically and persistently mentally ill. Population consists of both children and adults, many of whom are referred by Family Court and Child Protective Services. Student assignments include individual, family and group counseling.

**Medical Center 4
Flushing, NY**

Inpatient and Outpatient substance abuse and psychiatric treatment facility serving residents of Queens of all ages. Diagnostic and treatment services are offered including individual, group, family therapy, parent counseling. Interdisciplinary staff of social workers, psychologists, and psychiatrists.

**Queens settlement house 4
Forest Hills, NY**

A Queens settlement house is a multi-service agency which provides comprehensive services. Opportunities are available for work with groups, families, and individuals depending on the division to which the student is assigned. Community outreach may also be available.

**Community Mental Health Center 2
Bronx, NY**

A community based outpatient mental health center providing services to children, adolescent and adult populations. The intern works with the interdisciplinary staff, intern conducts intakes, group, family, and individual sessions in a variety of mental health settings. Some evening hours offered but not weekend.

**Neighborhood-based settlement house 1
New York, NY**

A neighborhood-based settlement house offering a wide range of services to adults and children. Counseling and case management, outreach to families, group work and school-based social work are among the services offered.

**Medical Center 9
Hackensack, NJ**

A private, not-for-profit outpatient mental health clinic serving individuals and families. Students will be assigned intakes, a caseload of long-term individual clients and two groups for children. **One evening per week is required.** Bi-lingual students would be welcomed.

**Counseling Center 7
Hempstead, NY**

A community based, multi-service agency for clients of Hispanic origin. Mental health clinic services (B), alcohol and substance abuse outpatient programs, youth and family counseling offer opportunities for a broad range of social work interventions. Students are given individual, family and group work assignments as well as community outreach and some program planning opportunities.

**Hospital 4
Holliswood, NY**

A private psychiatric hospital providing short-term, intensive inpatient treatment and outpatient services to adolescents and adults manifesting a wide range of mental disorders. Students provide individual, group and family therapy. Specialized programs: adolescent day RX, in-patient adolescent, acute in-patient psych, partial hospital (MICA, psych). Exposure to managed care environment.

**College Counseling Center 2
Bronx, NY**

Counseling program for students enrolled in this community college. Open until 7 pm weekdays.

**Outpatient mental health clinic 3
Brooklyn, NY**

Outpatient mental health clinic that serves a multilingual population (Russian, Spanish, Yiddish and English). Work with children, adults and seniors utilizing individual, couple and family treatment. Limited group work. Assignments will include work in Mental Health Clinic as well as Mobile Mental Health Team (home assessments) and may include Sundays and evenings to 9:00 PM.

**Community counseling agency 9
Jersey City, NJ**

A community counseling agency offering services to immigrants and their families.

**Housing Services 3
Brooklyn, New York**

This agency provides housing and rehabilitation services to individuals with mental illness and/or retardation within a wide spectrum of community-based settings. Individual, group counseling, case management, crisis intervention services offered. All ages. Offers some limited evening hours.

**Hospital 8
Port Jefferson, NY**

Community based medical facility offering a variety of opportunities in several units: the medical /surgical unit, discharge planning and short term counseling, the Adult Psychiatric Unit working with individuals and groups on a short-term basis and the Adolescent Psych Unit, working with adolescents and families.

**Mental Health 4
Far Rockaway, NY**

In addition to working with individuals, families and groups, this mental health program provides extensive in-service training. Population is mainly minority and residents of the Rockaways, usually lower socio-economic groups. Offers some evening hours.

**Psychiatric Center 3
Brooklyn, NY**

This Psychiatric Center provides in-patient and out-patient psychiatric services to an adult population with severe mental illness. Students are assigned to various units including forensic, MICA, and short-term. Individual, group counseling, discharge planning. Some placements are in satellite mental health clinics.

**Medical Center - Psychiatric Unit 7
Long Beach, NY**

An acute psychiatric unit providing short-term services to a wide age range of patients. Patients may be chronically mentally ill or suffering from acute mental illness. Students have the opportunity for individual and group work.

**Medical Center 7
Long Beach, NY**

An outpatient health care agency serving a multi-cultural, mixed socio-economic, bilingual population. Student will do psychosocial assessments, individual long and short-term counseling, crisis intervention and work as part of an interdisciplinary team. Agency is open to 7 PM.

**Medical Center 7
Long Beach, NY**

A mental health clinic providing clinical services to a voluntary client population. Students provide individual, family and marital services, functioning as social work therapists within the setting.

**Counseling Center 7
Elmont, NY**

Outpatient mental health clinic providing full range of treatment services to individuals, couples and families. Serves all ages. **Some evening hours required.**

**Outpatient mental health clinic 8
Dix Hills, NY**

This outpatient mental health clinic provides treatment services to children and families. Students will maintain a caseload of clients for counseling services. Population is diverse ethnically and socioeconomically and there is a wide range of presenting issues. Offers some

evening hours.

**Hospital 3
Brooklyn, NY**

Maimonides Hospital Community Mental Health Center offers a specialized day treatment program for the Latino community in need of intensive day mental health services. Bi-lingual/ English/Spanish is a must as services are provided in Spanish. This is a therapeutic community in a brownstone building. Services include individual counseling and a strong use of group modality

**Hospital 1
New York, NY**

This facility has extensive In Patient and Out Patient services: HIV/AIDS clinic, oncology, prenatal services, and an extensive program of mental health service. The intern usually rotates from the In Patient to the Out Patient facilities and works with other disciplines (i.e., Nursing, Psychiatry, Nutrition, and Medicine). Day and evening hours offered.

**Medical Center 7
Continuing Day Treatment Programs
Uniondale, NY**

A day treatment program for adults with severe mental illness, including MICA and elderly. Students provide individual and group services and participate in interdisciplinary team approach.

**Medical Center 7
Outpatient Mental Health Clinic
Garden City, NY**

An outpatient mental health and substance abuse clinic serving a racially and ethnically diverse population. Assignments include crisis intervention, individual, family and group therapy. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Medical Center 7
Partial Hospitalization Program
Uniondale, NY**

A short term outpatient hospital for adults with a psychiatric diagnosis, issues may include substance abuse diagnosis as well. Students will be assigned to two daily groups and carry a caseload of 2 to 3 clients for counseling, case management and discharge planning.

**Therapeutic day treatment center 2
Bronx, NY**

A therapeutic day treatment center and residential program for persons with history of mental illness. Individual counseling, group work, psycho-social assessments, and case management. Monitoring of medication and side effects.

**Medical Center 2
Bronx, NY**

An outpatient mental health clinic providing psychotherapy in the Russian language to the Russian emigre population in the Bronx. The clients served present a range of problems including chronic mental illness and mental impairment due to the stress of emigration. Students have the opportunity to do individual work and group work.

**Hospital 4
Elmhurst, NY**

This tertiary care, teaching medical center offers primary and secondary assignments throughout the hospital including adolescent health, family health, adolescent and adult psychiatry, ob/gyn, emergency medicine and mobile crisis. Additional learning opportunities include weekly student seminars, department meetings and related in-service training.

**Medical Center 7
Department of Social Services
East Meadow, NY**

A tertiary care hospital setting with a broad array of departments and opportunities for student placements. Students are assigned individual cases in a primary service (i.e.: pediatrics, psychiatry, etc.). Group and community organization assignments are available. This is a demanding, structured placement with many rich learning options.

**Counseling Center 3
Brooklyn, New York**

Therapeutic day treatment program for individuals suffering from chronic mental illness. Strong group work component.

**Counseling Center 8
Mattituck, NY**

This agency provides individual and group counseling to clients with a variety of mental health issues.

**Mental Health Counseling 7
Manhasset, Roslyn and Westbury, NY**

This is a family guidance setting providing mental health and counseling services to children and families from diverse backgrounds. Students are assigned as primary social work therapists in one the agency's clinic settings including "The Place" which provides services to children, adolescents and families affected by substance abuse.

**Hospital 7
Glen Oaks, NY**

Offers students a broad range of placement opportunities in inpatient and ambulatory settings serving people with psychiatric problems. Settings in which students have been placed include: Ambulatory Care Service (outpatient treatment for children, adolescents and adults

with a range of psychiatric disturbance); Walk-in-Clinic (Provides immediate assessment, referral, crisis intervention and short-term treatment); Geropsychiatry (providing a full continuum of care to older adults with a range of psychiatric problems); Inpatient Care Services (open and closed units for adolescents, adults and older adults); Supportive Living Programs (provide supervised apartment living for clients with a long history of psychiatric illness); Day Programs (providing continuing day treatment for severely mentally ill clients). Students placed participate in assessment, interdisciplinary evaluation and planning, individual, group and family counseling. Many students also receive secondary assignments in other areas of the Instructional Center.

Comprehensive School-Based Clinics 4

Far Rockaway, NY

There are two sites for these clinics which provide services to an indigent, racially diverse and economically disadvantaged population. Services are directed to the middle school age range (10 - 14). The issues in this community center on drug use and AIDS, much of the work involves grief and loss. Students will be assigned mostly group-work with some individual contacts with students and parents.

Hospital based Employee Assistance Program (EAP) 7

Students provide assessment, short-term individual, group and family intervention and referral services to employees of the North Shore Long Island Jewish Health System.

University Hospital Manhasset, NY 7

Approximately eight different sites for students in medical and psychiatric and chemical dependency social work settings. Medical settings may include: Inpatient Medical/Surgical Unit; Home Care; Child Development (serving children and adults who present chronic conditions including birth defects and genetic diseases); Oncology, and Neurology Units. Psychiatric Settings may include inpatient adolescent and adult units, outpatient and day treatment services. Chemical Dependency setting includes ambulatory and Day Treatment services. Student assignments include providing individual and group counseling, case management services, discharge planning, advocacy and outreach. Students have access to Grand Rounds, student seminars, department meetings and other medical center activities.

Counseling 8

Mattituck, NY

This family service agency provides clinical social work services to individuals, couples, children and families. Students will be assigned a varied caseload of both children and adults and can develop a group to meet the needs of population. Interns will be able to participate in staff meetings, case conferences and will provide intake and information and referral services. Day and some evening hours available.

Counseling Center 7

Oceanside, NY

An outpatient substance abuse, mental health and family counseling center where students carry a varied caseload. Clients are both voluntary and mandated for treatment. Opportunity for a placement with a focus on mental health, substance abuse or family therapy.

Mental Health Clinic 4

Woodside, New York

Mental Health Clinic and Substance Abuse Out-Patient center for a diverse client population, including newly-arrived Russian immigrants, troubled adolescents and parolees. Individual and family counseling, group facilitation.

Mental Health Clinic 9

Huntington, NY

A full service mental health clinic providing individual, group and family counseling. Population from children through adults with a broad range of pathology and presenting problems. Students receive group supervision as well as weekly individual field instruction and educational seminars. All students are required to be at the agency on Monday. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours. (Extended field placement - 14 hours a week through mid-August)

Outpatient community mental health clinic 9

Smithtown, NY

An outpatient community mental health clinic that provides individual, couple, family and group services for clients of all ages.

Continuing Treatment Center 9

St. James, NY

A day treatment program for adults with severe mental illness. Social work students are part of the interdisciplinary treatment team and have a rich opportunity for both individual and group work practice. Many clients are on medication and thus the need for collaboration with the psychiatrist and other team members.

Mental Health Counseling 9

Huntington, NY

Intensive outpatient treatment provided to adults and families affected by addictive gambling. Interns are trained to use specialized addiction assessment interviewing instruments as part of biopsychosocial intakes and co-lead psycho-education and treatment groups. Some work with individuals and families. Offers some evening hours.

Partial Hospitalization Program 9

Huntington, NY

This intensive, ambulatory treatment environment provides a range of mental health treatment service to people with severe mental illness. Social Work Interns function as a primary therapist providing weekly individual, conjoint family, group and crisis intervention services. Community education initiatives and other outreach components are available. Interdisciplinary team and strong professional environment.

Residential Programs 2

Bronx, NY

A community residential program for emotionally disturbed adults. Student assignments include individual, family and group work as well as some outreach work. Emphasis placed on encouraging and assisting clients to move into their own community apartment. Offers some

evening hours.

**Psychiatric Center 9
Brentwood, NY**

A New York State Office of Mental Health Psychiatric Center which provides inpatient, outpatient and residential living settings for people with severe mental illness. Students are members of an interdisciplinary treatment team and provide primary therapy services to population including individual, family and group practice.

**Mental Health Program 7
Baldwin, NY**

Sponsored by LI Council of Churches, this NYS certified community residence program provides restorative services to adults with psychiatric diagnoses. Programs include 2 supervised group homes and an apartment program. Student assignments - individual and group work.

**Partial Hospital Program 8
Smithtown, NY**

Provide individual, group, and milieu and collateral services with a client population with severe and persistent mental illness. Also operates a program for dually diagnosed clients. Team meetings and case conferences supplement individual supervision.

**Outpatient Counseling Services 8-
Riverhead, NY**

This is an outpatient substance abuse counseling center. Individual and group counseling during day and evening hours

**Mental Health Counseling 4
Flushing, NY**

Provides free/low cost counseling services to the Flushing area. Outreach services primarily through synagogue run groups. Individual counseling and educational programs as well. Offers some evening hours.

Case Management Services

Non-profit agency with case management and support services for victims of 9/11 and the local community. Services include Financial Assistance, Housing Help, Job Search/Preparation, Men's, Women's and Teen Support Groups, Individual counseling and Community Outreach.

**Multi Service Agency 4
Little Neck and Douglaston, NY**

A multi-service Jewish philanthropies agency providing group services and individual counseling to all age groups. Assignments have varied across a wide range spectrum from "Mommy and Me" groups to adult groups. Diverse presenting issues. Recreational, prevention, educational as well as therapeutic focus. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Multi Service Agency 4
Mental Health Clinic**

Little Neck and Douglaston, NY

A community based outpatient division of Hillside Hospital/LIJ Medical Center. Student assignments include psychosocial assessment, individual and family counseling with older adults. Services are provided both at the agency and in their homes. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Case Management Services 8
Sayville, NY**

This agency provides case management services to seriously mentally ill population who have been recently discharged from the hospital and who are attempting to re-establish their lives in the community. Evening and weekend hours available.

**Community-based multi-service agency 3
Brooklyn, NY**

A community-based multi-service agency offering a range of clinical and concrete services to a largely new immigrant population. Farsi speaking helpful.

**Psychiatric Center 3
Coney Island/Sheepshead Bay OPD**

Brooklyn, NY

A satellite outpatient psychiatric facility of the NYS Office of Mental Health Psychiatric Center on Staten Island. Students in this setting conduct intakes, provided individual and group counseling, attend staff meetings, in-house training and case conferences. Assignments are also available at the main hospital campus on Staten Island in both inpatient and ambulatory settings.

**Psychiatric Center 6
Staten Island**

Community Residential Treatment Services Unit (CRTS) is a Continuing Day Treatment Program for mentally ill adults who live in residences on the grounds of South Beach Psychiatric Center. Group and individual work.

**Hospital 7
Mental Health Clinic
Oceanside, NY**

An outpatient mental health clinic with hospital affiliation. Work with a multi-ethnic, client population from a wide range of age groups in

which psychosocial problems and psychiatric pathology are presented. Students provide clinical social work services with individuals, groups and families. Educational seminars are provided in addition to individual supervision.

MICA Program 9
Amityville, NY

This unit provides services to the dually-diagnosed (psychiatric illness and substance abuse) client. It is a detox unit, services are inherently short-term and consist of psychosocial assessment, educational and orientation groups, individual, group and marital therapy and referral to outside resources. Offers some evening hours.

Community Services 4
Bellerose, NY

Non-sectarian family setting which provides counseling and advocacy services in a multi-service community based agency serving a mixed socio-economic population. Assignments have included marital counseling and school adjustment counseling on an individual basis for adolescents, work with couples and adults.

Hospital - South Shore 4
Psychiatry

Far Rockaway, NY

The Department of Psychiatry offers both outpatient community mental health and day treatment programs for student placement. Work with a multi-ethnic, primarily lower income client population with severe psychosocial stressors and a range of psychopathology. Students provide clinical social work services with individuals and families with some group opportunity.

Medical Center 6
OPD

Staten Island, New York

This clinic provides students with the opportunity to work with an ethnically and racially diverse client population using individual, family and group modalities. This placement accommodates students who require evening hours.

Mental Health 6
Staten Island, NY

A community mental health center providing individual and group counseling.

Psychiatric Clinic 8, 7
Amityville, NY

A large community-based mental health agency with multiple locations in Nassau and Suffolk serving adults and children. They have several programs including an outpatient mental health clinic, a community support services unit, continuing day treatment, a Satellite Program, school-based programs and a community residence. Students have the opportunity for individual and group practice in both long and short term modalities. Offers some evening hours.

Mental Health Center 3
Brooklyn, NY

A community mental health agency affiliated with Lutheran Hospital servicing the largely Hispanic population of Sunset Park. Counseling services for adults and children with a wide range of family, school related substance abuse and psychiatric issues.

University Counseling Center 8
Stony Brook, NY

A counseling/mental health program serving a voluntary population which consists exclusively of college students and graduate students from this campus. Clinic has somewhat of a psychodynamic orientation. There is an in-service training program for social work students which is highly developed. Individual treatment is the primary focus of this placement but some work with families and groups is possible.

Counseling Center 7
Syosset, NY

A community counseling agency for adolescents through adults. Assignments include intakes, psychosocial and short term and ongoing counseling for individuals and families. Priority provided to service for drug and alcohol clients.

Behavioral Health Services 10
Stroudsburg, PA

This outpatient clinic provides students with the opportunity to work with an ethnically and racially diverse client population that includes, children, adolescents, and adults using individual, family and group interventions.

Office of Women's Services 8
Coram, NY

This department of the Town of Brookhaven serves adult women in a variety of ways--individual counseling, support groups, monthly workshops, and advocacy in legal rights; re: family, and also conducts an Information & Referral Hotline. Mostly day hours with one evening (to accommodate group).

Department of Human Services 8
East Hampton, NY

A community-based youth and family agency providing counseling services to individuals, groups and families. Student assignments include intake, case management, crisis intervention, home visits and collaboration with courts, schools and other agencies. Several groups are available for adolescents, single mothers and parents. Bilingual skills in Spanish are helpful but not required. Offers some evening hours.

Adult Day Center 7
Woodbury, NY

A medical model adult day care center providing services to eligible individuals with multiple medical problems, dementia and mental health needs. Services include nursing care, occupational therapy, nutritional counseling, recreational therapy and social work.

**Adult Outpatient Psychiatry Department 8
Stony Brook, NY**

Social work students are part of a trainee group that also includes psychiatric residents. Respected social work professional staff are part of this psychiatric department, so interdisciplinary collaboration is fruitful. Voluntary outpatient population with a wide range of disturbances. Emphasis on individual treatment but opportunities for family and group work are also available.

**Medical Center 8
Stony Brook, NY**

This teaching medical center provides assignments in a range of medical and psychiatric services including neo-natal, renal dialysis, surgery, neurology, and in-patient psychiatry. Students will be involved in case management, discharge planning, problem solving activities, and short-term counseling with individuals and families. Well-developed in-service training program. Opportunities for group work are limited.

**Medical Center 3
Brooklyn, NY**

The Department of Social Work offers students the opportunity to work with individuals and families on a short and long term basis. Students will provide case management services, counseling, psychosocial assessments, and crisis intervention and advocacy services.

**Family Services 8
Bay Shore, Coram and Centereach, NY**

These units are components of the YMCA of Long Island, a multi-service agency providing free or low cost counseling to children and adults. **Bayshore** site serves children and families in individual, family and group modalities. **Coram** site provides substance abuse counseling to adolescents and adults.

HOMELESSNESS/ DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

**Domestic Violence 9
Hackensack, NJ**

ADV serves adult male and female victims and perpetrators of domestic violence in an out-patient mental health setting. Services include 24-hour emergency hotline service, intake, walk-in services, individual, group and couple counseling, and legal advocacy. Students are assigned to all services.

**Multi Service Agency 1
New York, NY**

This is a short-term, 8-bed male residence for the homeless offering a wide range of services including counseling, case management, vocational and educational training, community outreach and congregate meals. Must do some hours each month on Sunday in soup-kitchen program.

**Case Management and Housing 8
Hauppauge, NY**

Linkage Program-a shelter for homeless clients. Provide crisis intervention and case management services. Evening and weekend hours available.

**Housing 1
Urban Family Center
NY, NY**

Henry St. is one of the nation's oldest social service agencies, serving Manhattan's Lower East Side. The Urban Family Center is a model transitional shelter housing 100 homeless families in individual apartments in six buildings, each with a live-in social worker. Social workers function as the Primary Case Manager for two families providing counseling, needs assessment, development of a family service plan, referrals, advocacy and helping families to prepare for permanent housing.

**Housing 2
Bronx, NY**

A 15 bed apartment unit in the South Bronx for families with children. Tenants with substance abuse history, HIV, or formerly homeless families. Primary services include on site case management. Opportunities for student: information and referrals, employment and education counseling, parenting and child development education, case management, group work.

**Case Management 8
Islip Terrace, NY**

This agency works with individuals and families by providing case management and psycho education services with the goal of preventing homelessness. Day and evening hours available.

**Domestic Violence 7
East Meadow, Garden City and Hempstead, NY**

This agency provides services to survivors of spouse abuse, elder abuse, and rape. It operates the only shelter for abused women in Nassau County. Students provide individual and group counseling services and take hotline calls. Opportunities for program development, community organization and research are currently being developed.

**Multi Service Agency 7
Hempstead, N.Y.**

A human service agency that provides support services for homeless families. Services include screenings, assessments, intensive case management, counseling, advocacy and education.

Housing Agency 1
New York, NY

A large, city agency administering and managing public housing for low-income families throughout New York City. The student project offers pre and post-counseling services to families re-located due to domestic violence. Extensive outreach, crisis intervention, individual and family counseling

Domestic Violence services 8
Wainscott, NY

Provides services to victims of abuse. Information and referral to community advocacy and counseling to residential and non residential clients. 24 hour hot line. Safe housing - 18 bed shelter. Individual, group, outreach, advocacy.

Transitional residence 2
Bronx, NY

A transitional residence for victims of domestic violence. Individual, group counseling, after-care programming, case management and advocacy. Some evening and week-end hours available.

Transitional residence 3
Brooklyn, NY

A transitional residence for homeless young women ages 16-21 and their babies. Services include individual and group counseling, educational and vocational counseling, home-finding services, day care, medical care and a host of other programs aimed at developing independent living. Assignments include intake, individual, group work with foster children or foster parents and concrete services.

Volunteers of America 1
New York, NY

A unit of a large, city-wide agency serving homeless and formerly homeless individuals and families, the mentally ill, substance abusers, troubled youth, ex-offenders, all of various ages and ethnicities. Opportunity for crisis intervention, short-term counseling, group work, resource development and service coordination.

Women In Need 1
New York, NY

Agency provides comprehensive programming for homeless and under-privileged women and children. Multiple sites offer individual, group and family counseling, substance abuse treatment, case management.

CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES/ SCHOOLS

Community based agency 8
Babylon, NY

This community based agency provides individual and family counseling. Clients range from the ages of 6 to 19. Crisis intervention and in-depth counseling is provided.

Bay Shore School District 8
Bay Shore, NY

This elementary school serves a multi-cultural community which offers a range of assignments including: individual and group counseling with children, parents and families; liaison work with the Committee on Special Education, local and county services.

Correctional Facility 5
Bedford Hills, NY

A maximum security prison for women. Students work as a member of a social work team doing short and long term work. Assignments include intake and assessments, individual and group work and advocacy.

High School 7
Bellmore and Merrick, NY

Students are assigned to provide a complete range of school social work services in 2 junior high, and 3 senior high schools. Emphasis is placed on assessment, crisis intervention, group work, and outreach, as well as individual counseling. Cases frequently involve issues of substance abuse, adolescent sexuality, and family stress. Students must be sensitive to the organizational dynamics of working in a school system. The placement begins approximately September 1st and extends 3 weeks beyond the regular field work calendar. A small stipend is provided for the additional weeks.

Residential Program 8
Melville (Sites in Melville or Yaphank), NY

This agency provides residential group home services to boys. Opportunities for students include intake, individual work, and group work. There are two sites: a group home in Yaphank and a residential home for foster care in Melville.

High School 8
Riverhead, NY

This agency provides individual and group counseling and crisis intervention to high school age students. Day hours only.

BOCES 7
Massapequa, NY

This special education school is a publicly funded program for physically handicapped children ages 3-21 years, residing in Nassau County. Referrals are made from local public school districts and students represent a diverse racial, ethnic and socioeconomic distribution.

Disabilities range from mild to severe physical and cognitive limitations. The field placement assignment includes individual and group counseling as well as family contacts, occasional home visits, referrals and other interventions. Multi disciplinary team participation.

BOCES 7

Baldwin Harbor, NY

An alternative high school for emotionally disturbed adolescents largely from disadvantaged backgrounds. The school offers academic and vocational programs. Students assigned to this agency provide individual and group counseling, lead support groups and conduct psychosocial interviews.

BOCES 8

Ronkonkoma, NY

Prior students in this setting were assigned to schools on Shelter Island and South Hampton, although other locations may become available. Opportunity for work with individuals, families and groups. Also assessments and referrals where indicated.

BOCES 7

Wantagh

This special education, high school setting provides academic, vocational, and counseling services to its students. Social work interns provide the students with counseling, individually and in groups, conduct psycho-social assessments, see families, participate in staff conferences and consult with multi-disciplinary team members to plan and implement student programs.

School District 8

Brentwood, NY

Placement in this K-12 public school district offers opportunities to work with children, their families and school staff in a multi-cultural community with children experiencing a wide range of social, emotional and behavior problems. Social work interventions include individual, group and family counseling as well as information and referral services to school and community programs.

Youth Bureau 8

Patchogue, NY

This program provides services to youth up to 21 years of age in the Brookhaven Township including services to runaway youth and their families (crisis intervention, advocacy, short term counseling, emergency housing placement, information and referrals), a housing program geared to help residents attain self-sufficiency (crisis intervention, concrete services, individual and family counseling and group work services).

School 7

Uniondale, NY

Placement in this K-5 public school district offers opportunities to work with children, their families and school staff in a multi-cultural community with children experiencing a wide range of social, emotional and behavioral problems. This is an innovative program with an opportunity to work flexible hours.

Mental Health Clinic 4

Glendale, NY

A community mental health center serving a Queens population composed of working class, ethnically diverse population. Social work students provide psychotherapeutic services to individuals, families and groups of all ages with some opportunities for collaboration with community agencies. Clinical issues include: sexual abuse, family violence, divorce, substance abuse, school problems, etc

Children and Family Services 4, 1

Jamaica, NY (other sites in Queens and Manhattan)

This multi service agency operates a broad array of services and programs including outpatient mental health clinic, residential services ("Youth Development Homes") and preventive service programs for children and families from diverse backgrounds. Students will provide individual group and family counseling, case management and advocacy and have the opportunity to engage in intra and interagency activity. In addition, the agency offers specialized assignments in youth and family services for HIV/AIDS populations, Street Youth, seriously emotionally disturbed adolescents, children and youth who are victims of abuse and neglect.

Schools 8

Central Islip, NY

Central Islip schools have a student population of approximately 5,000 in grades K-12 serving a racially and ethnically diverse community. Social work students facilitate individual and group counseling as well as crisis intervention, psychosocial assessments and referrals to outside agencies for concrete and mental health services. In addition, the elementary school worker coordinates the elementary drug prevention program. The Alternative High School offers some evening hours.

Community Center 4

Forest Hills, NY

This is a Jewish Community Center offering programs for toddlers and teens, special educational supplementary programs, senior adults recreational, social and interventive programs, an after school program, a nursery school and a full complement of services for Russian and Israeli immigrants. Casework, group work and organizational planning comprise student assignments.

Family Mental Health Services 8

Amityville, NY

An agency whose purpose and commitment is to care for the emotional needs of varied ethnic groups, of all socio-economic levels who are struggling with the issues of immigration, displacement, disenfranchisement, color and language barriers and the stress of being upwardly mobile. Case management, individuals, couples, group and family treatment. Work with: bereavement, depression, mid-life crisis, dysfunctional families, parent/foster parent education, child and adolescent problems/disorders, victims and perpetrators of domestic violence, etc. Offers some evening hours.

Counseling Services 7

Hempstead, NY

This placement will offer a student an opportunity to do individual and group counseling in day care centers in Nassau County. Student will also be involved in the Legislation and Public Policy Committee of the agency.

Multi Service Agency 2
Bronx, New York

This is a family enrichment program focusing on foster care prevention. Individual casework with families at risk. Some work with families affected by having a member with HIV. Multiple sites and a broad range of services.

Counseling Services 8
Brookhaven, NY

Provide group counseling to adolescents around age related issues. Primarily afternoon and evening hours available.

Child & Family Services 4
Jamaica, NY

This community-based program serve families involved with the Administration for Children's services through prevention programs, individual and family counseling, and parenting group programs.

Residential Multi Service Agency 1
New York, NY

A 24-hour crisis residence for adolescents and young adults dealing with issues of homelessness, poverty, unemployment, substance abuse and other mental health issues. Other programs include Mother/Child Residence for teens, transitional housing and community resource centers. Individual/group counseling. Special application required. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

High School 8
Islip Terrace, NY

This program offers the student opportunity to do crisis intervention, individual and group work with adolescents in a high school setting. There is emphasis on substance abuse counseling and prevention, some work with the court system, families and the larger community will be required.

School District 8
East Hampton, NY

This agency works with elementary school age children and families. Individual and group counseling opportunities available. Day hours only.

BOCES Day Program 8
Oakdale, NY

Alternative High School program provides academic and vocational training plus individual and group counseling to clients, ages 14-21 years from diverse, ethnic and socio-economic backgrounds. Student interns perform intakes, case management, provide advocacy and counseling services.

High School 7
Elmont, NY

A high school setting in a multi-cultural, economically diverse community. Assignments include individual and group counseling, crisis intervention and family work. Collaboration with school staff. A bilingual (spanish/english) student would be a particular asset in this setting.

Student Health Center 3
Brooklyn, NY

A student health clinic in a racially diverse area of Brooklyn. Students present a variety of issues such as abuse and domestic violence, pregnancy and emotional issues. Treatment is short-term and crisis oriented. Assignments concentrate on group work.

High School 4
Springfield Gardens, NY

This is one of several small high schools located in a large public high school in Springfield Gardens Queens. Good opportunity to provide counseling services to adolescents from 13 - 18; In addition, to individual counseling with students, there is opportunity to co-lead group sessions.

Multi Service Agency 7 (See specific setting)
Mineola, NY

A new large, private multi-service agency created from the former Children's House and Family Service Association. This new agency has an array of services for both children and adults including residential services, mental health services, and substance abuse services. Some of the specific settings offer some evening and/or weekend hours.

Children's Services

Programs serve children ages 12-21 who cannot live at home due to abuse, neglect or homelessness. They also provide services to families with children who have special needs. Their programs include emergency shelter services ("The Haven"), community residences ("Walkabout"), independent living services, a family mediation program, a respite program for families with children with emotional handicaps, and a nursery coop which provides respite child care and support to parents seeking employment or attending educational/vocational training.

Adult Services

Programs include outpatient mental health and chemical dependency services at **Elmont** (2 eves. required), outpatient substance abuse services in **Hicksville**; (Treatment targeted to primary substance abuser and significant others. 1 to 2 eves. required); outpatient day treatment alcohol program is available in **Hempstead**. In these programs students can expect to work with individuals, families and groups.

**Community Based Program 4
Queens Village, NY**

Under the auspices of the Episcopal Diocese, this community based preventive service program serves children and families with the goal of strengthening the family unit and working toward prevention of placement. Students provide individual, family and group counseling, case management, advocacy and concrete services in-agency and through home visits. There are also opportunities for community organization practice through participation in coalition and committee activities.

**Preventive Services 3
Brooklyn, NY**

Family Dynamics Inc. is a non-profit preventive services agency servicing adolescents and families. Programs include family counseling, parenting, education and a respite center. The Bedford-Stuyvesant site also includes male and female adolescent rap groups, grandparents support groups and an after school program. The Bushwick site includes adolescent groups in the high schools and a day care center for teen parents. Both sites provide individual counseling.

**School District 7
Farmingdale, NY**

Work with at risk population, mainly elementary school level, and their families. Social work students function as liaison between home and school as well as counseling individual students. Home visits and work with families living in motels for the homeless are major components of placement. Social work students may have the opportunity to work with a mothers' group, community agencies and concrete services. Collaboration with teachers and other educational personnel is an essential facet of placement.

**Youth Outreach 7
Freeport, NY**

This is a comprehensive youth service agency that provides counseling, tutoring, leisure time and cultural enrichment services. Clients are of diverse cultural background, providing students opportunities for a rich experience of individual and family work, both within the agency and in the community (schools, probation, health services, court, and other welfare services).

**School District 7
Glen Cove, NY**

Glen Cove School District serves students in grades K-12 from diverse ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds. Working in a Host setting, social worker provides individual (short and long-term) counseling, group work (children of divorce, self-esteem and socialization) crisis intervention, conflict resolution, etc. Parent education groups, some work with families. Assist with coordination Drug Prevention Program. Spanish speaking population in Glen Cove.

**Multi Service Agency 3
Brooklyn, NY**

Multi service agency operates a broad array of services and programs including foster care case management, residential services and preventive service programs for children and families from diverse backgrounds.

**Graham-Windham Services 1, 2, 5
NY, Bronx, Westchester, NY**

This school-based setting provides opportunities to work with 6th, 7th, and 8th grade students deemed at risk by teachers or parents. Students also can self-refer for primarily individual counseling, with family involvement.

**Children's Services 1
New York, NY**

Agency operating a group residence for gay, lesbian, transgender and bisexual youth.

**High School 7
Franklin Square, NY**

This high school provides students opportunity for placement within the regular high school or within the Transitional Program. The transitional program is a self-contained educational and therapeutic program for students with severe emotional impairment. In both programs there is opportunity for individual, group counseling and crisis intervention with mixed socio-economic community. Clients present a wide range of issues. Students also work with parents and collaborate with school staff.

**School 8
Dix Hills, NY**

This is a school district placement providing an opportunity to work with a diverse population. Social work students are placed in the Special Work Program which is a component of the Special Education curriculum and targets Middle and Secondary school students that are emotionally handicapped and/or learning disabled. Social Work students facilitate individual and group counseling as well as crisis intervention and referrals to outside agencies. Students are part of the Transition Services Committee (community services) to prepare students and their families for their future.

**Prevention Services 4
Queens, NY**

Placement is in one of the following offices - Far Rockaway or Jamaica. Students will have the opportunity to work with families at risk. Relationships will be made with both parents and their children. Opportunities exist for individual, family, and community contacts. Placement can accommodate extended students. Day time hours are required.

**Community Based Program 3
Brooklyn, NY**

This is a community-based program serving an ethnically diverse population of children, families, adults and the elderly. Offered are after-school programs, support groups, benefits advocacy, substance abuse prevention and senior center programming. Strong group work

emphasis. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Public Schools 7
Hempstead, NY**

Hempstead Public Schools serves a diverse population. Assignments include social histories, home visits, work with children and families and work with special populations such as at-risk children. Modalities involve work with groups and individuals. The school district has a strong focus on drug prevention with a program targeted for at-risk children. Referral sources to the drug prevention program come from teachers, parents and the student support team.

**School 3, 4
Laurelton, Brooklyn, NY**

Birch is an early childhood intervention center serving children ages birth to 5 years with developmental disabilities. The population is diverse both ethnically and economically. Students will carry a caseload of families, with do intakes and have the opportunity to run short and long-term groups.

**Public Schools 7
Woodmere, NY**

This is an elementary school setting. Assignments include individual and group counseling (banana splits socialization groups), outreach to parents, and work with special education students and families. Additional learning opportunities include faculty and departmental meetings.

**Youth Council 7
Hicksville, NY**

This is a voluntary agency with county youth board and state funds. Its services are varied. There are professional social work services to individuals, mostly teens, and families. There is a peer counseling group. There is work to form parents and teen problem solving groups. There are varied recreational services, a teen tutoring program, and a crime prevention program, with a multi-disciplinary staff. Offers some evening hours.

**Children's Services 7, 8
Amityville, NY**

This agency provides center-based clinical and concrete services. Population is drawn from the agency's four group homes which are run for adolescent males and females ages 14-18. Students are assigned group homes and provide psycho educational support as well as individual, group and family counseling. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Community Based Program 9
Pt. Jefferson, NY**

Bi-county, not for profit community based agency that provides residential and counseling services to young people and families in crisis. Counseling center provides: play therapy, substance abuse services. Wellness seminars and parent effectiveness programs provided to high schools and colleges and on-site school based social work services provided at many local schools. Offers some evening hours.

**School 8
Huntington, NY**

School District placement providing opportunity to work with diverse population. Students' assignments may include children and families from pre-school through high school. Practice modalities utilized encompass individual, family and group counseling. Students are required to travel between schools and make home visits.

**Youth Bureau 8
Huntington, NY**

This is an agency offering a broad variety of services to youth of Northport, East Northport, Huntington and neighboring communities. Services include after-school programs, substance abuse prevention and treatment services, youth development programs, etc. Students have the opportunity to work with groups and individuals, facilitate parent workshops and interact with community organizations. Afternoon to evening hours will be required in most of the Youth Bureau's settings.

**School 7
Jericho, NY**

Work with elementary school population and their families, providing play and group therapy, crisis intervention, active participation in interdisciplinary school-based support team, some in-class presentations. Additional learning opportunities include faculty and departmental meetings.

**Multi Service Program 1
New York, NY**

JBFCS operates an extensive and diverse network of community based programs, residential facilities and day treatment facilities throughout the 5 boroughs, Westchester and Long Island. Students are placed in the **Madeline Borg Mental Health Clinics**, the **Pride of Judea Mental Health Center**, various group homes and residential treatment settings, child welfare prevention settings, partial hospital, day hospital and day treatment settings. Students provide individual, group, family and community practice.

**Community Center 6
Staten Island, NY**

This agency is a community-based center providing a variety of programs for youths, adults and seniors through educational and recreational activities. Students are assigned individuals and a number of groups including the Teen Lounge, singles leadership group, and a parenting group. Interns may also make home visits to homebound seniors and perform some administrative work.

**Community House 3
Brooklyn, NY**

This is a community based agency providing comprehensive social, cultural, educational and recreational services to residents of the Bensonhurst and surrounding communities. The JCH is the leading service organization for refugees from the former Soviet Union.

Programs are provided for children through senior citizens. Students will be assigned individuals for counseling several groups to develop and organize and community organizing work with tenants in a Senior Housing Project.

Early Intervention Services 7
Garden City, NY

This is a provider of Early Intervention, Preschool and school age services for children with special needs. A team of professionals from multiple disciplines address the children's and families' needs both in the program and at home.

Community Based Program 3
Brooklyn, NY

This is a community-based center serving children, families, adults and the elderly. After-school programs, support groups, special programs for seniors, the learning disabled, victims of Alzheimer's disease and caregivers. Strong group work emphasis. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

School 8
Lake Grove, NY

A residential facility for troubled and in trouble adolescents. Youngsters are referred by courts, Department of Probation, and other social service agencies. Intake, ongoing counseling, assessment and referral services and education is provided. There are group services as well. Adolescents range in age from 14-18, and this is a multi-ethnic, multi-social population. Clients come from both Long Island and New York City.

Children and Family Services 4
Jamaica, NY

A community-based foster care and adoptions agency serving a racially and socioeconomically diverse youth population. Students carry a caseload of long term clients, providing concrete and therapeutic services. Students' primary role is ongoing counseling on an individual and family basis and the coordination of other services. Home visits are required.

School 7
Lawrence, NY

This school setting divides the placement between the Early Childhood Center in Inwood and an elementary school in Cedarhurst. At the Early Childhood Center, students work with special education kindergarten students and their families, doing home visits, individual work with children and outreach work with the families. Assignments also include social histories, group work, participation in Child Study Team meetings and consultation with teachers and outside community agencies.

Mental health and educational services 4
Queens Village, NY

This school setting combines mental health and educational services in a day treatment model for seriously disturbed children (ages 3-16 years) and their families. Student assignment includes providing clinical social work services to individuals and groups, liaison with family, school and community and collaboration with interdisciplinary team.

Public Schools 8
Lindenhurst, NY

Students are assigned individuals and families from the elementary through high school level. Individual and family counseling for mixed socio-economic school district. Group work is also available. The assignment requires a five day per week commitment with a stipend for hours beyond the field instruction requirements.

Children's Services 8
Wading River, NY

Private, not for profit voluntary multi-function child care agency with offices in Brooklyn, NY and Wading River. LI Location: residential treatment center for 95 children, ages 8-14; group home program - adolescents 14-21 years; foster boarding homes; cluster therapeutic foster homes; day program, (child day care); cottage program (severely handicapped men and women). **New Life Program** (family care placements adults 21+ with mentally retardation diagnosis and adoption services. Intern duties: assessments, collateral agency/court contacts, individual, family counseling, etc.

School 7
Locust Valley, NY

This intermediate school setting offers student direct practice opportunities with children and families experiencing a range of interpersonal and family problems. Individual, family and group modalities.

Schools 7
Long Beach, NY

This elementary school in an ethnically diverse district offers the student the opportunity to do play therapy, group work, crisis intervention, community outreach and social histories and the opportunity to work with families. Home visits are required. Students will also be encouraged to attend Child Study Team Meetings, Pupil Personnel Services Meetings and Faculty meetings.

Crisis Center 7
Bellmore, NY

This program of the Long Island Crisis Center serves gay and lesbian youth ages 12-24. Services provided include a hotline, short-term counseling, groups and education services to the community. Students will be assigned individual cases, group work, crisis intervention, advocacy work, family contacts and will provided information and referral.

GLBT Youth Services 8
Bay Shore, NY

This is a youth agency dedicated to the problems and issues facing gay and lesbian young people from teens to young adults. Students may work at a number of different sites doing individual and group counseling. The agency focuses heavily on community organizing as well,

which involves outreach to communities.

**School 4
Bayside, Queens**

Lowell School is a private, not-for-profit day school for learning disabled and emotionally disturbed children. The students are enrolled in small classes and receive mandated related services including counseling, speech and language therapy, and occupational therapy. The role of the social worker at Lowell School is to provide individual and group counseling to students, serve as a supportive liaison to the teaching staff and provide resource and referral services to the parents.

**Residential Program 8
Yaphank and Port Jefferson, NY**

A residential setting for children with emotional and development disorders from pre-school through high school. Many children come from an inner city background and are on medication. Social work intern works with students on an "outside of classroom" basis. Opportunity to form significant long-term relationships with youngsters. Also, interns actively work with other treatment team members.

**High School 7
Massapequa, NY**

Placement is at a high school location. Population is from a socio-economic and ethnically mixed community. Opportunity for individual, group and family work around issues of AIDS, drug and alcohol abuse.

**Multi Services Children's Agency 7
Syosset, NY**

Services to families and children ages 0-18, a truancy group, a parenting group. Primarily ACS referrals, some church and school referrals and some walk ins. Counseling and case management services. Hours 9-5 T, Th, F, Mondays 9-7, Weds 9-8

**School 7
Merrick, NY**

This school district offers work only in the elementary schools, with student interns providing supporting casework services to elementary school children and their families, group work services training 4th through 6th graders to work with younger grades, as well as conducting socialization groups, compile social histories, and provide concrete and advocacy to families.

**Multi Service Agency 7
Plainview, NY**

This is a large multi-service agency primarily serving the Jewish Community but open to all. The "Y" offers a wide range of services to all ages from pre-school to teens to the elderly. There are a number of programs available in each of these categories. Students have the opportunity for individual, group and community work. Specialized bereavement counseling groups are also available. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Youth and Family Services 7
Mineola, NY**

A non-profit agency providing individual, family and group counseling, after school activities and community outreach. Services are offered on-site and in schools to predominantly an adolescent population. Student assignments consist of individual counseling, training adolescents to become peer counselors and some family work.

**School 7
New Hyde Park, NY**

This high school provides opportunity for individual, group counseling and crisis intervention for high school students from a diverse socio-economic community. There is a wide range of presenting issues. Students work within an interdisciplinary collaboration. There is some collateral work with parents.

**New York City Board of Education 4
Glendale, Maspeth, Middle Village, Elmhurst, Corona and Ridgewood, NY**

This is a universal pre-kindergarten program servicing Glendale, Maspeth, Middle Village, Elmhurst, Corona and Ridgewood. This is a school based community multi service setting where students will have the opportunity to work with individuals, families and groups. Opportunities for crisis intervention, individual and family counseling.

**New York City Board of Education 4
School Based Support Team
Ozone Park, NY**

A school-based multiservice agency serving School District 27 in Queens. Students are placed in various programs including a family counseling center, a medical clinic, and an alternative high school and in programs for homeless children.

**New York City Board of Education 4
Forest Hills, NY**

In this school setting, students conduct psychosocial histories and provide counseling services for both students and their guardians. The client population is multi-ethnic and from various social economic strata. Student(s) conduct groups and participate in staff meetings.

**New York City Board of Education 1
New York, NY**

School Social Work with students K-12. Assessment, crisis intervention, counseling with children and family members. Some opportunity for group work. Inter-disciplinary team collaboration, treatment planning. Should be willing to stay until June.

**New York City Board of Education 4
Bayside, NY**

Provides a challenging internship within a large, multicultural high school setting in Bayside, Queens. Spark was originally created to support adolescents dealing with substance abuse problems but also serves students experiencing depression, conduct disorders,

academic underachievement, eating disorders, socialization concerns, identity issues, family conflicts, etc. Students are assigned a primary setting in the Guidance Dept. and secondary under the Spark program.

NY Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Children 1

New York, NY

Agency working with children and families, specializing in visitation for parents and children who are involved with Family Court and/or custody cases.

Service to Families 1

New York, NY

Provide services to at-risk families. Case planning, individual counseling, group work with parents. Inter-disciplinary collaboration and advocacy.

Schools 7

North Babylon, NY

Elementary school, problems ranging from anger management, behavioral problems, family, individual and group work, community service and outreach.

Schools 7

N. Bellmore, NY

Students work with an elementary school population providing individual and family counseling. Assignments include working within an interdisciplinary framework to provide psychoeducational services as well as linkage information and referral.

Hospital Based Autism Program 7

Bethpage, NY

Opportunity to work with children with autism spectrum disorders and related neurological disabilities. Individual and family counseling

Multi Service Agency 1

Brooklyn, NY

Multi service agency operates a broad array of services and programs including residential services and preventive service programs for children and families from diverse backgrounds.

Schools 7

N. Massapequa, NY

Students provide services to a junior high school population. Assignments include individual and group counseling, working with an interdisciplinary team to conduct intakes and provide psychoeducational services and advocacy

School 7

Port Washington, NY

This school has children from a wide socio-economic background. They might be Black, Asian, Latino or White. Individual and Groups are the modes of intervention.

Autism Services 4

Astoria, NY

Provides services to persons with autism and their families. Services range from early intervention and pre-school programs for young children to day programs and residential services for adults. Provides educational and support services to family members and caregivers.

Multi Service Agency 4

Queens, NY

Outpatient mental health agency, which in 1994 added a special program to provide bilingual/bicultural services to the Asian community in Queens. Multiple services to children and their families are provided. The agency provides a student unit with both individual and group supervision and participation on a multi-disciplinary team.

Children's Psychiatric Center 4

Bellerose, NY

This New York State Office of Mental Health Children's Psychiatric Center provides a full range of psychiatric services to children and adolescents. Students provide clinical social work services utilizing individual, family and group modalities as part of an interdisciplinary treatment team. Students have been placed in the adolescent or mid childhood inpatient units, outpatient clinic, and early or midchildhood day treatment program. Students attend Grand Rounds, assigned committee meetings, student group supervision and Social Work Department meetings.

School 8

Riverhead, NY

This agency provides social work services in school and with some home visits to 5th and 6th grade students. They offer individual counseling, as well as conducting social skills and anger management groups. The agency is open from 8:30am to 3pm, Monday to Friday during a school calendar schedule. No evenings or weekends.

School 7

Rockville Centre, NY

A high school setting in which students will provide crisis intervention, individual and group counseling on a short and long term basis and work as part of an interdisciplinary team. Home visits may be required.

School 7

Roosevelt, NY

This school district provides support services to children and families of mainly African-American background and diverse socio-economic background. Social work interns work with individual students with academic or behavioral difficulties. Home visits may be required.

**School 8
Holtsville, NY**

This large school district serves several communities in central Suffolk. The district has social workers in each school building providing short term individual counseling, group work and family contact. Students will have opportunities in each of these areas.

**Children's Psychiatric Center 8
Dix Hills, NY**

This NYS Office of Mental Health Psychiatric Center offers a rich array of children's psychiatric services through interdisciplinary inpatient, outpatient and day treatment programs. Student tasks include individual, family and group practice in on campus and satellite programs throughout Suffolk County.

**Schools 8
Sayville, NY**

Elementary and High School placements, family, group and individual counseling, diverse cultural and socio-economic population; work with at risk population; collateral work with families, professional staff and committee on special education.

**School 2
Bronx, NY**

Provides counseling for students enrolled in middle school.

**Family Services 2
Bronx, NY**

Programs serve children ages 12-21 who cannot live at home due to abuse, neglect or homelessness. They also provide services to families with children who have special needs.

**High School 7
Floral Park, NY**

High school setting in which students will provide individual and group counseling services, crisis intervention, and some outreach. Home visits and a small amount of evening hours may be required.

**Multi Service Agency1
New York, NY**

Multi-faceted program for low-income single mothers and fathers and their children affected by homelessness, substance abuse, incarceration or domestic violence. Group work services for both children and adults, outreach, individual counseling and advocacy. Some evening and week-end hours available.

**School 8
Smithtown, NY**

In this school district, students work primarily with special education children in the elementary, middle and high schools, providing counseling, evaluation, and crisis intervention. Students provide psychosocial histories, weekly counseling, biweekly and conduct several groups.

**After school based programs 8
Patchogue, NY**

Interns work in after-school programs in various Suffolk County school districts. Group work and developing and implementing psycho education programs to adolescents. Day hours only.

**Clinic: On-site School Program 2
Bronx, NY**

As part of a community mental health agency, this on-site school program in a local junior high school, provides individual and group work for students identified by parents and teachers as having behavioral and academic difficulties.

**School 8
East Patchogue, NY**

Primary school for diverse group of children ages five through eight years. Intern provides play therapy, individual and group work and crisis intervention. Active participation in interdisciplinary school based support team and home visits with parents are also built into this assignment.

**Community Program 2
Bronx, New York**

Work with adolescents residing in group homes in the north Bronx area. Individual counseling to adolescents with mental health, behavioral, substance abuse, and family abandonment issues. Inter-disciplinary collaboration, participation in Service Plan Reviews. Must have good oral and written communication skills. Some limited evening hours may be available.

**Multi Service Agency 4, 7
Jamaica and Rockville Centre, NY**

This multi-site, multi-service agency provides continuum of care to children, adolescents and their families including foster care and intensive foster care at these two locations.

**Children's Services 4
Jackson Heights, NY**

Students work with children and families at risk. Assignments include counseling individual children and/or parents around psychiatric, behavioral problems. Issues of parenting skills and abuse and neglect are addressed. Many clients are mandated to come for services.

Focus of treatment is on prevention and development of more functional family dynamics and interactional skills. Emphasis on crisis intervention and assessment. Group work is provided as well.

Residential Treatment 8

Dix Hills, New York

This is a residential treatment center for seriously troubled adolescent girls. Students assist girls both individually and in group, conduct intake assessments, and participate in team meetings. Limited contact with parents, and teachers in the on-premises school.

Children and Family Services 7

Syosset and Garden City, NY

This agency is a foster care preventive and residential facility. This particular site is a residential facility serving males ages 10-17 with emotional disturbances. Assignments include assessments, interviews, court appearances and home visits. Home visits take place in all metropolitan counties.

Community Center 8

Commack, NY

Provides a range of social group work services to all ages. Students also have the opportunity to work with individuals and with the community. Student led groups include: mommy and me, couples, bereavement, single young adults, latch-key kids, separated and divorced, children of separated, divorced and step-families, etc. Social work students also have opportunities to conduct intakes and provide recreational programs. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

School 4

Forest Hills, NY

A special education school for children who are learning disabled and emotionally disturbed. Student assignments include individual counseling and group work. Some opportunities are available for family work.

The Door 1

New York, NY

Agency providing planned parenthood case counseling for youth to age 21.

School 8

Stony Brook, NY

Students work with a junior high school population, providing individual and group counseling services.

Multi Service Agency 7

Cedarhurst, NY

This is a non-profit agency serving the orthodox Jewish community in the Five Towns. The focus is on work with at-risk teenagers and includes outreach to schools and families, individual and group counseling, advocacy and linkage services.

Youth Bureau 8

Babylon, NY

This community based agency provides individual and family counseling. Clients range from the ages of 6 to 19. Crisis intervention and in-depth counseling is provided.

Youth Bureau 8

Huntington, NY

The Town of Huntington Youth Bureau represents and serves the needs of youth under the age of 21. The Youth Bureau works in conjunction with contracted youth service agencies to meet the special needs of youth, their families and the community. Student assignments include outreach, program development, individual, groups and family counseling. Clients reflect a broad range of socioeconomic, ethnic, cultural and religious backgrounds.

School 7

Uniondale, NY

A large school district serving a racially and ethnically diverse community. Social work students are placed in both the high and junior high schools working with individuals and groups. Also opportunities exist to work with parents and in collaboration with school officials.

School 7

Wantagh, NY

Intern is assigned to a senior high school program serving a middle class population. Assignments include individual cases and groups for adolescents around such issues as divorce, truancy, depression, disruptive behaviors, developmental issues and occasionally special education.

School 8

W. Babylon, NY

Students will work in the elementary, Jr. High and sr. high schools providing individual and group counseling, crisis intervention and family services. Home visits may be required. Interns will lead two 9th grade groups as well as groups in the elementary and high schools.

School for Child Development 4

Whitestone, NY

This program provides early intervention and CSE services to children from birth to five years of age. Intern works as active member of interdisciplinary school based support team and has extensive collaboration with referring community agencies. Assignments include bio-psycho-social assessments and supportive interventions with children and families on site and in their homes.

Youth Services 7

Levittown, NY

There are two segments to this placement. The first involves prevention in the schools in which the student in concert with the field

instructor or agency staff makes weekly presentations in the local schools (probably elementary or middle schools, public and parochial). The presentations require use of group work skills with latency age children and young teens. The second part of the placement is intake/counseling with children and teenager and their parents. Community programs and groups are part of the assignment.

Counseling Center 7

Massapequa, NY

This non-profit, community based organization serves youth, ages 12-21 and their family members, emphasizing prevention, support and treatment. Services include individual, family and group counseling, outpatient substance abuse treatment, vocational counseling and job placement, and parenting programs. The social work student will have the opportunity to focus on clinical skill development and community outreach and prevention.

School-Based Program 7

Massapequa, NY

This program is administered by YES Community Counseling Center and is designed to provide social work services to all the elementary schools in the Massapequa School District. Students are assigned to one school to complete their placement and work in collaboration with other school personnel such as psychologists and health services educators. Students have the opportunity to work with individual children, to develop groups, and to provide referrals to children and families. Offers some evening hours.

Multi Service Agency 1

New York, NY

A large multi-function agency servicing children, adolescents, adults and the elderly. Youth programs, pre-school, remedial education, substance abuse prevention, health, pregnancy, employment and personal and family counseling are offered. Strong group work emphasis.

GERIATRICS

Adult Day Health Center 3

Brooklyn, NY

A comprehensive residential community serving the elderly and people with Alzheimer's disease. Social work students provide individual, group and family services as a member of a professional care plan team.

Nursing Care Facility 8

Amityville, NY

This is a long-term care nursing home and rehabilitation facility in which students may do discharge planning, individual work, group work, family work and crisis intervention.

Community Center 2

Bronx, NY

Community center providing services for senior citizens. Agency also operates an apartment program for senior citizens. Has some evening hours.

Multi Service Agency 4

Forest Hills, NY

This is a Jewish Community Center offering programs for toddlers and teens, special educational supplementary programs, senior adults recreational, social and interventive programs, an after school program, a nursery school and a full complement of services for Russian and Israeli immigrants. Casework, group work and organizational planning comprise student assignments.

Assisted Living Program 7

Plainview, NY

This is a full service residential setting for independent older adults where a unit of social work students provides individual, family and group services addressing a range of adjustment difficulties and familial issues. Evening/weekend hours available.

Medical Center 7

Franklin Square, NY

This hospital offers placements in the Medical-Surgical Units, the Adult Day Program and the Geriatric Care Center. Students provide individual work to patients with a range of medical diagnoses within an interdisciplinary approach. Discharge planning, linkage to other community services and brief short term counseling. Some longer term counseling is also available.

Diagnostic Center and Skilled Nursing Facility 1

New York, NY

This is a municipal nursing facility and certified Home Health Agency addressing medical and social service needs of residents. Adult and geriatric population. Assignments include crisis intervention, mental health services, and home care follow-up.

Geriatric Center 8

Commack, NY

Gurwin is a multi-service health facility serving, primarily, a geriatric population. Social work intervention focuses on individual and group services to facilitate a better quality of life.

Assisted Living 7

Oyster Bay, NY

This is a special residence designed to offer a comprehensive approach to caring for people with Alzheimer's disease and related memory disorders. Social Work students will provide individual, family and group services addressing a range of adjustment difficulties and familial issues.

Nursing Home 4

Queens, Jamaica, NY

Voluntary, non-profit nursing home serving population of elderly with varying degrees of disability. Large proportions of the population are

holocaust victims. Nursing home is of very fine quality, with large staff of social workers, and an interdisciplinary approach. Provides good learning opportunities. Students work with individuals, some family members, groups of residents, patient advisory council groups. Appropriate setting for student interested in advanced gerontology social work practice.

**Nursing Home 3
Brooklyn, New York**

This is a long-term care facility for 500+ older adults. Intake, individual/group counseling, inter-disciplinary care planning, case management.

**Skilled Nursing Care 4
Jamaica, NY**

Students in this long term nursing care facility work with individuals and families and conduct intakes and formulate treatment plans.

**Hospital 4
Flushing, NY**

Health Outreach program serves senior population. Student assignments: develop groups, educational programs, community outreach, and information referral.

**University Hospital 7
Extended Care and Rehabilitation
Manhasset, NY**

The Center for Extended Care and Rehabilitation is a skilled nursing facility with an innovative rehabilitation program for older adults, after a hip fracture, stroke, amputation, or de-conditioning due to illness. The center has both short-term and long-term beds.

**Geriatric Institute 7
New Hyde Park, NY**

Parker provides a wide range of programs and services to older adults who live in community, to residents of the facility who need short term evaluation and to older adults who require on-going institutional care. Students provide service to individuals, families and groups.

**Community Services 4
Queens, NY (several locations including Bayside and Flushing)**

Multiple sites with both community and residential settings serving well and frail older adults. Students provide individual and group services in both long and short term modalities, and may do program development.

**Assisted Living 7
Oyster Bay, NY**

A comprehensive residential community serving people with Alzheimer's disease and Related Memory Disorders. Social work students provide individual, group and family services as a member of a professional care plan team. Offers some evening and/or weekend hours.

**Health and Home Care Division 3
Brooklyn, New York**

Home-based counseling services to elderly and disabled adults. Multi-ethnic population. Individual counseling, crisis intervention, mediation between caregivers and clients, support groups, client advocacy.

**Case Management Services 8
Suffolk, NY**

Provide case management, individual and group counseling services to older adults and family members in a long term residential setting. Day hours only.

**Community Residence 6
Staten Island, NY**

A geriatric residential and day program for severe mentally ill older adults. Individual and group work (primarily activity centered and living skill focused) are assigned to social work students placed in this agency.

**Residential Facility for physical, emotional and life cycle issues 4
Queens Village, NY**

This is a residential care facility for clients who are primarily elderly with physical, emotional and life cycle issues. The social work student is a member of the interdisciplinary team and has opportunity to provide short and long term counseling with individuals and groups. Social work interns provide individual and group counseling services in an educational milieu to children and young adults with cerebral palsy and their families. Some community work is also available.

DEVELOPMENT DISORDERS

**Pre-School 7
Inwood, NY**

Crossroads is an educational and therapeutic pre-school serving children ages birth to 5 years with a variety of handicapping conditions. Students have the opportunity to do play therapy with children both individually and in groups, to work with parents individually and in groups, conduct psychosocial intakes, do outreach to other agencies and organize special events.

**Disabilities Institute 7, 8
Huntington, Plainview and Bayshore Branches
Smithtown, NY**

This is a school for the developmentally disabled which also offers some residential care. Work is primarily with families and community

agencies, as well as assisting parent with guardianships as children "age-out". The Plainview facility offers services for "aged-out" developmentally disabled adults.

Multi Service Agency 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8

Center Moriches, Central Islip, Far Rockaway, Hempstead, Smithtown, Syosset and Queens, Brooklyn, Manhattan, and the Bronx, NY

FEGS is one of the largest human services agencies on the East Coast. The locations listed above are part of a network of Mental Health Clinics providing individual, family and group work practice to a diverse client population, ranging in age from children to adults. Student program is vast and monthly student meetings (held in Manhattan) are required.

School 8

Bayshore, NY

This agency does individual and group work with pre-school age children with developmental disabilities. Day hours only.

Case Management Services to college students 8

Central Islip, NY

This agency provides case management and group and individual counseling to college age students diagnosed with neurological deficits. Some late afternoon and evening hours available

Developmentally Disabled Services 7

Garden City, NY

This nonprofit agency for the developmentally disabled provides case management and individual and group work services for individuals with developmental disabilities and their families. Advocacy efforts for this population are an important aspect of the work.

FORENSIC SOCIAL WORK

Correctional Facility 5

Bedford Hills, NY

This is a maximum security prison for women. Students work as a member of a social work team doing short and long term work. Assignments include intake and assessments, individual and group work and advocacy.

Forensic work 1

New York, NY

Agency working with families and children who are involved in the Family Court system.

Forensic work 1

New York, NY

Agency providing case management, anger management and counseling for individuals at risk of incarceration.

Forensic Services 3

Brooklyn, New York

This is an agency specializing in assessment and treatment of adult sex offenders. Cognitive/behavioral model using group treatment approach. Largely a mandated population. Some individual/family counseling available. Offers some evening hours.

Department of Corrections 1

New York, New York

This is an agency specializing in assessment and treatment of individuals with a criminal record. Cognitive/behavioral model using group treatment approach. Largely a mandated population.

Department of Probation 1

New York, NY

Operating in all five boroughs, this agency provides case management and counseling for individuals on probation. Students will also run groups. Open until 7 pm, weekdays.

County Probation 8

Yaphank and Hauppauge

Day Reporting Center, Hauppauge is an alternative to incarceration for pre-adjudicated and adjudicated persons. Students work with individual and groups addressing an array of psycho social issues related to maintaining law abiding behavior. Probation-community based supervision, provides early intervention programs are available for juvenile offenders. Social workers work with individuals and families in this program. Sex Offenders Unit, students work as members of clinical team with adult and youth sex offenders. Individual, group and family intervention.
