

STUDENT STATEMENT OF UNDERSTANDING*

Prior to beginning field education, all students are expected to be familiar with the policies and practices of the Field Practicum. Therefore, following an orientation session, students are expected to sign the following statement indicating their understanding of the following components of the Field Practicum:

1. The course objectives for field education;
2. The process for securing a field placement;
3. The integration of field with course work;
4. Field placement assignments (learning plan, process recordings, monthly report, evaluation);
5. Time frame and due dates for assignments;
6. Evaluation and grading process;
7. Expectations of the specific placement year and program;
8. Differing roles and responsibilities of field education staff and faculty;
9. Process of addressing and resolving concerns or problems in the placement;
10. NASW Code of Ethics.
